

Temporary modification of data over 3 Airac Cycles

If a NOTAM or Supplement modifies data for 3 AIRAC cycles (or 3 months if effective dates do not coincide with AIRAC dates). The following policies apply: -

- If the source document makes changes to data with an existing unique identifier (E.G Approach ILS 24-Z) 24 hours/ 7 days a week for the duration of effectivity. Then the temporary data shall be incorporated by NAVBLUE and the permanent data removed.
- If the source document includes data with a new unique identifier(s) 24 hours/
 7 days a week for the duration of effectivity. The new temporary data shall be incorporated by NAVBLUE and the permanent data retained.
- If the source document makes changes to data with an existing unique identifier and the changes are not effective 24 hours/ 7 days a week then the data shall reflect that which is effective for the longest operation hours.
- If the source document makes changes to existing unique identifiers and the effective period does not coincide with AIRAC cycle dates, then the data shall reflect that which is effective for the longest period within that AIRAC cycle.
- If the source document includes data with new unique identifiers and the
 effective period does not coincide with AIRAC cycle dates, then the new
 temporary data shall be incorporated by NAVBLUE up to the end of the
 subsequent AIRAC cycle and the permanent data retained.
- If the source document makes changes to data with existing unique identifiers and the period of effectivity begins/ends precisely between two AIRAC cycles NAVBLUE shall follow-up with the state for clarification. If no clarification or modification from the state is received before production closure the permanent data shall be retained.
